Proposed Constitution change regarding deacons at Providence Church, to be voted on at April members meeting.

- **Present:** They shall be publicly appointed to fulfill the duties of their office indefinitely and shall be removed from office by death, voluntary resignation, geographic relocation, or disciplinary action.
- **Proposed:** They shall be publicly appointed to fulfill the duties of their office for a single four (4) year term and shall be removed from the office by death, voluntary resignation, geographic relocation, or disciplinary action. The term of service shall begin on Promotion Sunday and end on the fourth anniversary of their start date. A Deacon may be asked by the Elders to extend their term of service for an additional year if there are no available candidates for the Deacon office. Former Providence Church Deacons may be eligible for reappointment after a one (1) year break in service.
